Application Checklist – International Applicant

Candidate's application is considered complete once all documents listed below have been received electronically. In addition, official transcripts, certificates of degree, and signed confidential financial statement (if applicable) must be received by the Department of Computer Science & Engineering. International students submit either TOEFL or IELTS scores. Only completed applications can be reviewed by the Admissions Committee.

Documents to be submitted electronically:

- ___ Completed online application
- ___ Application Fee – non-refundable fee must be paid by credit card VISA or MasterCard
- ___ Three letters of recommendation – must be submitted electronically
- ___ Statement of purpose and personal history statement – must be submitted electronically. Resume is not acceptable in lieu of these statements
- ___ GRE score – Ph.D. and M.S. applicants should request ETS to send score electronically to UCR
- ___ TOEFL or IELTS score – Request score issuing institution to send score electronically or via regular mail to UCR
- ___ Supplemental financial statement – Ph.D. applicants only. Must be completed electronically

Documents to be mailed:

- ___ Official transcripts: one copy in original language and one English translation
- ___ Official certificates of degree/diploma: one copy in original language and one English translation
- ___ International student confidential financial statement – required only after admission offer is made
- ___ Bank letter – required only after admission offer is made
