The thesis is original research work, and it should demonstrate the student’s ability to study a research area, identify an open problem, and make a research contribution. The thesis requires a presentation and must be approved by a committee of at least three faculty members.</p> <p>In the thesis option, up to 12 units of CS 297 Directed Research or CS 299 Research for Thesis or Dissertation courses can be counted towards elective requirements</p>
